# **MAIN IDEA**

#### **STARTER**

- Look at John 17:20-23 read it together as a group and dig into the question below
  - From what you see in the church, have we been the answer to Jesus' prayer for unity?
  - Is the way that I conduct myself helping or hindering the realization of that prayer in the church?
- Whether inside or outside the church, we need to love people and love starts with getting to know people. Are you open to getting to know someone who thinks differently than you?

## **CHALLENGE FOR THE WEEK**

Spend time with at least one person who has a much different idea about culture or politics than you. Make an effort to understand them and don't try to argue or convince them of your point of view. Just seek to understand.
