

MIDDLE GROUND

Week 2 – September 11 or 15

What's something awesome you've seen that completely amazed you?

What have you had to put your faith in before *without* having all of the answers? (e.g. *flying in a plane*)

Are any of the tensions or questions mentioned in the message things you've wondered about before? If so, which ones?

Why do we sometimes feel the need to have all of the answers before making a faith decision?

Do you feel like it's risky to ask hard questions about your faith? Why or why not?

What would it look like to trust Jesus and still pursue answers to your questions?

Who do feel safe enough to share your questions with?

Next Step: Leaders—end this week small group discussion by asking students to fill in finish this sentence: "I wonder _____ about [**God/science**]." The goal is for students to build on this week's discussion by sharing some of the questions they have about God and science.

Then, before you wrap up group for the week, remind your students to keep posting questions in the group text you started last week. If a student shares a question that another person in their small group has also wondered about, encourage them to "like" that question in the group text. This is a great way to not only let your students connect, but also to start expressing openly and honestly what they wonder about God.
